A Note From Audrey Visiting God at Church Camp

When I was seven years old, I fell in love with church camp. It felt like God lived there. All year I ached for it. But I lived for those weeks with the mountains and the lake and rainstorms, for singers and brass and handbells and organ, for hammock confessionals and candlelight vespers. At camp, I felt whole. Closest to myself, closest to God.

Imagine how hard I fell coming home. I was devastated to be back in the ordinary. For weeks after, I moped around the house, logging the three-digit countdown for when I got to visit God again. Every year it was the same. Until it wasn't.

I remember the moment distinctly. The benediction of our camp worship service turned into a processional out onto the lawn, all of us singing. I looked up into the trees and felt a burst of sunlight warm my face. I wondered, what if this joy isn't trapped here in the mountains? What if the joy had never come from the place at all?

It was then that I realized what really made camp a holy experience for me. It wasn't the physical location. It was because everyday, I spent sunup to sundown in worship and study and fellowship. The mountains merely allowed me to experience my faith uninterrupted. I had done myself a disservice, thinking God lived at church camp. I had confined God to the mountains, and in many ways, I left my faith there, too.

After that summer, the way church camp informed my faith changed. Instead of waiting all year long until I get to leave the ordinary behind, why not try to inject the ordinary with more church camp?
